## Wild Rice Days Arts & Crafts Vendors TERMS and CONDITIONS

Please keep this for your records

### FEES

1. 100% of the fees must be returned with the Application/Contract by **June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2009** in order to hold your spot. If not received by that date, your space will be leased to someone on our waiting list. The Application must be filled out completely. Incomplete applications will be returned. All vendors that show up at the festival without a paid-in-full application must pay a \$20.00 penalty fee - no exceptions.

### JURY MATERIAL

2. Enclose or Email two (2) 35mm or digital photos representative of your work, and one (1) of your booth. Can be on one 8 ½ x 11 sheet, uncut. All photos become the property of the Wild Rice Days files.
3. If you are accepted, your application then becomes a Contract and takes effect when the contract is signed off on by a committee official and 100% of the fees have been received.
4. You will receive a confirmation, a map of the downtown area showing your location, and a lot number. The street locations will be marked with chalk on the street or sidewalk. The grass locations will be marked with bright paint on the grass.
5. No parking in the exhibitor areas during show hours. There are limited designated areas at the park (weather permitting) for exhibitors that require a vehicle or trailer type unit as part of the display.
6. There is no electric or water available.

### SET UP DAYS AND TIMES

NOTE: We are now allowing all types of vendors; Hand-Craft Vendors will be located north of the railroad tracks. Manufactured and Informational Vendors will be located south of the railroad tracks.

7. **Friday set up time: 8:00AM to 12:00PM** available to Vendors who want to participate in the Friday Afternoon Sneak-Peek. (Check-in at the Wayside Rest Area's Log Cabin. No one will be in the park directing vendors. You MUST stop at the Log Cabin for check-in. The Wayside Rest is on Hwy 210 on the east side of town. There is a turn-around available.)
8. **Saturday set up time: 6:00AM to 9:00AM** (WRD committee members will be wearing **YELLOW** shirts and will be available along Maddy Street to direct you, should you need it. They will also be around during show hours for any questions or issues needing to be resolved.)
9. McGregor Wild Rice Days Festival is held **RAIN or SHINE; NO REFUNDS.**
10. All Exhibitors are required to maintain booths until 4:00PM Saturday. Anyone tearing down before the closing time will absolutely not be considered for next year's festival.

### GARBAGE LOCATIONS

11. All garbage must be bagged and placed in a dumpster or carried out. Receptacles will be along the route.
12. Booth space is non-transferable and exhibitors are restricted to their designated space.
13. Exhibitors must provide their own tables, display units, chairs, canopies and wind weights.
14. Awnings are not allowed. Some spaces are "full sun" so be prepared.
15. Exhibitors are not allowed to sell or give away any food or beverage.

# Media Categories\*

Wild Rice Days offers many separate categories in which to apply and exhibit in the Hand Crafted Division, in the Manufactured Division and now offers a new Informational Division. While a balanced show, which equitably showcases fine arts and crafts as well as diversity among media, is a primary objective, Wild Rice Days has no quota in any medium.

## Hand-Craft Items

**Art:** Works created using dry media including chalk, charcoal, pastels, pencil, wax crayons, etc. or from fluid medium of inks and washes applied by pen or brush. Works created in oils, acrylics, watercolor, etc.

**Bath & Body:** All items consisting of lotions, soaps, perfumes, supplements and related materials.

**Ceramics/Pottery:** All original clay and porcelain work other than jewelry is accepted in this category. No machine-made or mass produced work is permitted.

**Clothing:** All hand-crafted, wearable items. Mass produced pieces are NOT permitted.

**Fiber:** All work crafted from fibers including basketry, embroidery, weaving, leatherwork, tapestry, and papermaking. No machine tooling, machine-screened patterns or other forms of mass production are permitted. No factory produced wearable items, regardless of additional modification or enhancement by the artist may be exhibited.

**Glass:** No forms of mass production are permitted.

**Home & Garden:** All home-use items along with lawn/garden type ornaments, tools or gadgets.

**Jewelry:** All jewelry, produced from any medium or materials must be entered in this category. No commercial casts, molds or production work is allowed.

**Metal:** Includes all non-sculptural, non-jewelry works crafted from metals. No production studio work allowed.

**Mixed Media:** Includes 2 and 3 dimensional works that incorporate more than one type of material to produce.

**Photography:** Artworks created from photograph. Prints of photographs made from the artist's original negatives must be processed under the supervision of the artist.

**Sculpture:** Three-dimensional original work created in any medium.

**Stone:** Works crafted from stone.

**Wood:** Original works in wood that are hand-tooled, machine-worked, turned or carved.

## Manufactured Items:

Art, Bath & Body, Clothing, Home Party & Jewelry. These categories are for all machine productions, mass productions, and factory produced items. **Manufactured items cannot be mixed with handmade items.** You will be asked to remove one or the other.

## Information/Education/Demonstration:

This category was created for any organization displaying informational/educational items only or any demonstration of an organization's services. Please clarify whether you are Government, Community, Organization or Individual.

If you are selling something you **do not** fit into this category; **Non-Profit** organizations fall into this category, but **must provide their 501© status certificate.** If no certificate is provided, they must pay the regular lot fee. No exceptions.

\*If there is something you sell that is NOT on this list, please contact the McGregor Area Chamber of Commerce to verify that your items will be allowed.
